Mim then had a quiz with name things eg. Vegetable, Towns, animals etc. on a list starting with "S". This was quite difficult cutting out all conversation.



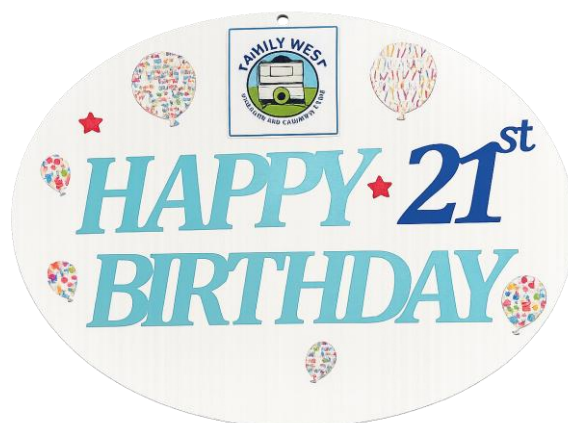
